- First meeting with EAN Board, President of ESNR, and co-chairs of Panel NI on 1.7.2019 to discuss a Memorandum of Understanding with the European Society of Neuro-Radiology (ESNR)
- Memorandum of Understanding is also being considered with the European Association of Nuclear Medicine (EANM)

- Massimo Filippi (MF) declares to step down as co-chair of the Panel.
