Minutes of EAN Scientific Panel on Higher Cortical Functions

Hybrid Business Meeting Budapest 1July 2023, 10:30-12.00(CEST)

- 1. Welcome to the Hybrid Meeting by Co-Chairs: Isabel Pavão Martins and Noa Bregman.
- 2. Apologies: Olivier Godfroy was unable to connect via link
- 3. Proposals for the next EAN Congress Helsinki 2024. It was agreed that a complete draft of the proposal in the format available at EAN site must be sent to the panel co-Chairs until the 15th July. (Final submission deadline for Management Group: July 24, 2023). The following proposals were discussed:
 - **1- Focused workshop/ Symposium proposed by Masud Hussein.** Visual recognition and agnosia.
 - 2- Interactive session/ Case Based discussion proposed by Masud Hussein | Chair M Hussein or Isabel Pavão Martins. Functional cognitive disorders/ Subjective cognitive complaints (collaboration with the scientific panel of functional disorders). M. Hussain suggested a lecturer Wiesje van der Flier from Amsterdam
 - 3. **Teaching course proposed by Pedro Alves.** Brain networks, Tractography, and cognition (joint project with imaging?)- How to do it, How to analyse data. Emphasis on cognitive and neuropsychiatric disorders suggested speakers Michel Thibaut de Shoetten or someone from his group.
 - 4. Focused workshop proposed by Irena Redkorova | Chair: Irena Redkorova Cognitive reserve also covering cognitive rehabilitation.
 - 5. **Symposium proposed by Isabel Pavão Martins | Chair: Noa Bergman** Cognition in awake surgery. To cover testing, contribution to knowledge, single neuron evaluation. Possible speakers Itzhak <u>fried</u>, Hugues Duffau (Montepellier)
 - 6- Focused workshop/Teaching course proposed by Thomas Brandt & Marianne
 Dieterich Lateralization of brain functions. If possible, to produce a session that does not overlap the one on Neurodiversity presented at Budapest by FESN.
 - 7- Interactive session (teaching with questions) proposal by Olivier Godefroy- Brain-Kidney interactions with a special focus on cognitive impairment-to be confirmed
 - 8. **Focused workshop, s**uggestions forwarded to **Umberto Volpe** for a shared meeting with European Psychiatric Association to be discussed with the EPA.Neuropsychiatric disorders how to differentiate brain disease from primary psychiatric symptoms; delusions due to brain lesions- features, treatment, outcome. Other topics are possible.
